POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

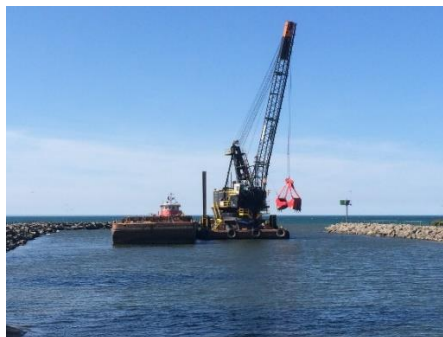
- Safely operate barge mounted lattice boom cranes.
- Operating a friction crane, such as a Manitowoc 4000W and/or Clyde Whirley, to perform duty cycle dredging with clamshell bucket, pile driving, place rip rap and armor stone, etc.
- Performing daily inspections of crane, rigging, barge, and associated equipment.
- Ensuring load is within lifting capacity of the crane.
- Maintaining required equipment logs.
- Performing required maintenance and repairs on crane.
- Assisting construction crew out of the crane on an as-needed basis.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

- Member of the Operating Engineers Union
- NCCCO Crane Operator Certification – Lattice Boom Crane.
- 3+ years experience working as a crane operator with at least 1 year experience dredging.
- Rigging and Signal Person Certifications.
- Welding Certification - beneficial but not required.
- Willingness to work up to 12-hour shifts, day or night, 7 days a week throughout the Great Lakes.
- Must have basic knowledge of crane machinery in order to assist in servicing or repairing of the crane.
- Commitment to work safely and follow all safety policies and procedures.
- Transportation to and from jobsite (valid driver's license).
- Comfortable working on and around water.
- Complete a pre-employment physical examination and drug screen.

Compensation, retirement, medical, apprenticeship and paid holidays all in accordance with the Great Lakes Floating Agreement, collectively bargained with the International Union of Operating Engineers, and Federal Davis Bacon requirements.
